Woodview Shinny Pad Code of Conduct



All Players are required to abide by this Code of Conduct. One Representative (18+) is required to read and sign this Code of Conduct prior to participating in the program.

Helmet Requirements

- All skaters must wear a CSA-approved helmet.
- Participants under 18 are required to wear a helmet with a cage (recommended for all skaters).

Shiny Pad Regulations

- There will be NO CONTACT
- Players will refrain from any rough play that could put themselves or other participants at risk of injury. i.e., intentional hooking from behind
- Players will refrain from any negative behaviour or making any negative or derogatory comments.
- Players will rotate shifts to allow fair ice time and will work with others to ensure teams are of equal playing ability
- Players will respect and consider the safety of other players. Competitive Play is NOT Aggressive Play.

Shiny Pad Rules

- Recreational hockey only—no contact.
- No slap shots or raised pucks.
- Stick blades must stay below the knees.
- One puck allowed on the surface at a time.
